Responsibilities include data entry, direct voter contact, event logistics and volunteer recruitment, training and management.

Additionally, the campaign is also offering a fellowship program for applicants who are looking to take their involvement with the campaign to the next level. Fellows will be required to have a greater time commitment than interns and will participate in our Field Organizer Training Program, where they will not only learn the basics of campaign field and data work, but will also gain in-depth knowledge of grassroots organizing and targeting and modeling techniques so that they are ready to work on, and eventually run, campaigns of their own in the future.

The Koster for Governor internship and fellowship programs are designed to be an enriching educational experience, where participants will engage in daily field activities, learn from and have access to seasoned campaign staff, and hear from a variety of political guest speakers.
