NOTES

- 1 Architecture** majors at KSU ordinarily take ARCH 325 "Environmental Design and Society" this semester. Since UMKC does not offer that course, UMKC students will take an elective instead, and then take ARCH 325 in lieu of an elective in their third-year at KSU.
- 2 Interior Architecture & Product Design** at KSU accepts ENVD 301 & 302 as equivalents of their IAPD 307 & 320.
- 3 Interior Architecture & Product Design** majors at KSU ordinarily take IAPD 430 "Visual Communication" this semester. Since UMKC does not offer that course, UMKC students will take an elective instead, and then take IAPD 430 in lieu of an elective in their fourth- or fifth-year at KSU.
- 4 Interior Architecture & Product Design** majors will take IAPD 210 online from KSU, in lieu of ENVD 247.
- 5 Interior Architecture & Product Design** majors will take IAPD 456 "Intro. to Product/Industrial Design" online from KSU, in lieu of an elective.

* Students can fulfill the English requirements by taking either DISC 100 + DISC200, **OR** with ENG 110 + ENG 225 (or their equivalents). DISC and ENG credits may not be mixed.

General Electives can be taken in any field outside architecture, however, KSU will accept no more than 3 total hours of recreation credits toward graduation.
