Proposals for solo and group exhibitions will be considered for 4-6 week exhibitions.

## **Curatorial Proposals**

Curators committed to developing and expanding their practice are invited to submit proposals for a gallery exhibition. Proposals from curators should include work from artists that contributes to contemporary dialogues in art and pushes the concept of curator in new and interesting directions.

#### **Submission Guidelines**

#### Solo and Group Proposals

Please provide the following when submitting a proposal for a solo or group exhibition:

- A current artist statement (per artist)
- Proposed exhibition time-line
- Exhibition proposal, no more than one page in length
- CV
- A brief explanation detailing why the work/exhibition proposed is a good fit for our program
- 5-10 samples of current work or planned work relevant to the proposal. Please list materials, dimensions and year (if applicable).
- Images (up to 3 MB each). Files, direct links (web).
- Video and Audio should link to the following media outlets (YouTube, Vimeo and SoundCloud)

### **Curatorial Proposals**

Please provide the following when submitting a proposal for a guest-curated exhibition:

- Curatorial Statement and CV
- Proposed exhibition time-line
- Artist statement(s)
- Exhibition proposal, no more than one page in length
- A brief explanation detailing why the work/exhibition proposed is a good fit for our program
- 5-10 samples of works by the included artists, including a corresponding numbered checklist of works; including title, date, materials, and dimensions.
- Images (up to 3 MB each). Individual files and DropBox links accepted.
- Video and Audio should link to the following media outlets (YouTube, Vimeo and SoundCloud)

#### Special Events

Please allow 3-4 weeks lead-time before planned date for event, and provide the following information when inquiring about holding an extracurricular event with UMKC Gallery of Art:

- Type and brief description of event
- Time-line
- Space needed
- Contact information of all persons involved
- Any other relevant information
