APPLICATION FOR PERMANENT ALIEN EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATION

Pursuant to Section 20 CFR 656.10, you are hereby notified of the intent to file an application for permanent alien certification for the following position:

Clinical Assistant Professor in Kansas City, Missouri

Job Duties: The faculty member will provide clinical instruction and oversight for pre-doctoral dental students. This includes instruction and evaluation of students in diagnosis, treatment planning, restorative dentistry, removable, fixed, and implant prosthodontics, endodontics, and non-surgical periodontics. The faculty member is expected to provide didactic and preclinical lab instruction, as assigned. Qualified candidates may be eligible to participate in faculty practice one day per week.

Minimum Requirements: DDS degree. Alternate degrees accepted: DMD or equivalent. Alternate degree requirement for non-US candidates with foreign professional dental degrees: Master's degree (or equivalent) in Dental Science, Dentistry or closely related field, and board eligibility in general dentistry or restorative dentistry. Candidates must be eligible for licensure/teaching permit in Missouri.

Must have proof of legal authority to work in the United States.
