

UMKC GLOBAL AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

OVERVIEW & REQUIREMENTS

By sharing their stories and encouraging others to study abroad, Global Ambassadors play an important role in helping to internationalize the UMKC campus. Global Ambassadors write blogs, post to social media, and serve as a peer advisors to future Roos Abroad. UMKC Global Ambassadors agree to fulfill the steps below and will earn UMKC Certificate of Global Engagement upon completion.

Step 1: Tell Us About Yourself

Once your application is accepted, complete the *Global Ambassador Profile* by submitting a photo and brief biography through the UMKC Globetrotter Portal.

Step 2: Learn the Ropes

Global Ambassadors must attend the Roos Abroad Social Media & Blogger Training in advance of their program departure. See the UMKC International Academic Programs Events Calendar or email international@umkc.edu for more information.

Step 3: Share Your Experience

Sign up to take over the @umkcstudyabroad Instagram account for one week during your program. Write one post for the Roos Abroad Blog leading up to your program's departure and at least three posts while abroad. Additional posts are welcome and encouraged.

Step 4: Give Us Feedback

Once your program ends, log in to the UMKC Globetrotter Portal to submit a photo of yourself from your time abroad with a quote about your experience. Complete the study abroad program evaluation administered through Qualtrics.

Step 5: Pay It Forward

Staff the *Ask a Global Ambassador* table the Annual UMKC Study Abroad Fair in September. Ambassadors who have a class conflict or expect to graduate before the Fair may request an alternate volunteer activity.
