'Honors Leader' noted on transcript only Add requirement that they must be an honors student to catalog copy.

Recommendation and vote: Gayle Levy recommends we approve new transcript notation. UCC Approved.

- Minimum GPA for Majors and Minors
 - ~30 ba/bs programs (non-specialty)
 - ~16 specify a minimum GPA or minimum grade within the major (3 require 2.5; all others 2.0)
 - ~8 specify a minimum GPA or minimum grade within specific coursework or not specified
 - ~6 specify a minimum UM GPA of 2.0 or do not specify

Minors:

50 minor programs

- 25 have no minimum grade or GPA specified (50%)
- 25 have a minimum grade or GPA specified within the minor (50%)
 - Would need transition protocol if a minimum is established.
 - o Reed: would prefer that 2.0 within minors is the standard
 - Should be any courses applicable to the minor that count in the minor.
 - Is there data that can be reviewed to see how many students it would affect to establish a minimum GPA?
 - Just UM GPA can be pulled in the report
 - Audits can be set up as courses last taken, highest grade, or whatever faculty want the audit to do.
 - Prefer highest grades that would fit in to those requirements.
 - Add UG Certificates to recommendation
 - For example, Arts Entrepreneurship Certificate is both Bloch and Conservatory which minimum grades should be used?

Recommendation: Minimum 2.0 GPA with highest grades calculated that meet the minor and UG CERT requirements.

Recommendation: Major minimum GPA needs to be discussed by units.

Next steps:

- Take back to units and discuss and bring back for discussion next month (Nov)

Communication and Journalism [COM-JRN]

Using the same course ID.

Replaces current COMM-ST courses (ALL)

CIP Code: 09.9999

Rationale: In order to align with the department name and structure and to make 'Journalism' be more visible to students.

Implications: Core 42, Essentials, Transfer Equivalencies, Catalog, Transfer Guides, Major Maps, Degree Audit?

Recommendation: Propose COMM for COMM-ST courses and JRNL for Journalism courses rather than a combined subject code. All courses are 'communication' but not all courses are 'journalism'.

- Must have sound logic for cross-listing.
- Should list course as counting in the major or degree.

- Consensus within UCC is to add ENGLISH 225 as a prereg for all WI courses
- Rationale is that they are all upper level (300/400) and would need a prereq or higher order

Honors Leader Catalog Copy

Honors Leader Requirements

To help students develop the skills they need to solve social problems and address important issues, the Honors Program offers students the option to complete the Honors Leader Program. The program is a series of four one-credit courses focusing on the four Honors pillars: social justice and cultural awareness, environmental sustainability, leadership and ethics, and Kansas City history and urban engagement. Upon graduation, students who complete the series of classes in addition to the University Honors requirements are designated and recognized as Honors Leaders. This designation will be noted on the student transcript.

Honors Leader courses include discussion groups, guest speakers, and community service. One course is offered each semester during a two-year period with the program repeating every two years. Honors students may also take one to three courses for Honors credit without earning the Honors Leader designation.

Honors Leader Courses:

HONORS 360A	Social Justice and Cultural Awareness	1
HONORS 360B	Environmental Sustainability	1
HONORS 360C	Leadership and Ethics	1
HONORS 360D	Kansas City History and Urban Engagement	1



Minimum Major/Minor GPA

Not all programs at UMKC specify if a 2.0 GPA is required within the major or minor in the catalog.

UCC recommendation needed:

- Establish a minimum GPA requirement for majors and minors
- Leave as is (audit enforcing degree and UM System GPA only, unless otherwise specified)




Minimum GPA for Majors


Coursework GPA or Min Grade Specified






Minimum GPA for Minors


Cross-Listed Courses
